


# Steins gate elite walkthrough

Steins; The Gate is a much more complex affair than most other visual novels. This largely stems from its basic gameplay mechanics: phone trigger system. Instead of being presented with an explicit, binary choice, as in other visual novels, your interaction with the Steins; The gate is completely diegetic and is carried out using the phone Okabe. The route you go through and the ending you receive is determined by your responses to emails you receive, whether you make phone calls when you are given the opportunity, and whether you are even reading incoming messages. It's worth playing the game through at least once on impulse to see which of the endings you get before you tackle other routes. You can unlock all the endings in one passage with some strategic savings along the way though, and that's what this guide will focus on. The hardest way to unlock, unsurprisingly, is the truth ending, as it requires you to take some very specific action over the course of history - including several situations where you have to choose not to act. Note, however, that launching flags for True Ending may prevent you from seeing some alternative scenes or reading different posts as the game progresses, so You can engage in extra passing to clean up the scene you missed. This guide, which should be mostly spoiler-free, was compiled with a step-by-step guide IBM5100.net and flowchart from The Steins; Vicky's Gate. So there may be some minor differences in the text you see. If you happen to discover any glaring errors along the way, please note in the comments, and we will adjust the manual accordingly. Management does not refer to decisions that do not have a significant impact on history or ending. If you are presented with an option not specified here, do not hesitate to experiment - save in advance if you are worried! Without further ado, then, let's get started. El Psi Congoru. When installing a timer on PhoneWave, enter anything other than reaching 120 10 times to achieve Clumsiness at Homerun level. When you receive an email from Mayuri about Upa, reply with Upa and then open the attachment from the reply it sends you for the RaiNet Talisman Achievement. When Faris emails you about the final battle to answer with the Red Cross, then open the attachment from the answer it sends you to make progress on Princess Chaos Achievement. When Mayuri email you with a theme it's interesting to open an attachment to make progress on Hero RaiNet Achievement. Chapter 2 When you receive a letter from Faris about the original sin level response from 2000. When you receive an email from Luke saying: I made a sweetness response with the family. When Faris hires you again, open the app to make progress on Songs of Chaos. When Mayuri calls you, answer him. When Luke emails you with the topic My family respond with my sister. When Kuris calls (Okabe has her in his phone as an assistant) answer him. When moeka sends you a message asking for information? Read it to see the scene with Kurisu. When Luke emails you with a topic about my older sister you should get a brutal sister achievement. Answer you know. Chapter 3 WARNING at the beginning of this chapter as there is a branch point with Faris's email messages. When Faris emails you say: PHANTASM is a feline meow! Answer with the theme song and then RaiNet Kakeru on her next post to make progress on Hero RaiNet achievement. Also, the answer with FANTASM and then the chaos to make progress on the Songs of Chaos. When Luke emails you about frogs reply with Hero Froggies. When Luke emails you with more news about frogs, open an attachment to make progress on Froggy Fad demise achievement. When Daru calls, answer him to see the scene with him and Mayuri, or ignore her for the scene with Kuris. Chapter 4 OF THE WORLD at the beginning of this chapter as a choice for some achievements and the choices needed for the True End are mutually exclusive. When Mayuri emails you about lotteries, reply with a big. When Luke emails you about RaiNet, open an attachment to make progress on Hero RaiNet Achievement. When Kurisu email you ask: Have you written this? The answer is with the report and then in the chapter, a cup of noodles to get the Discontinuous Kvalia achievement. You will not reach the True End if you make that choice. To call one of the True Ending flags, instead respond with then later bad scientist, do better, outsider, shame and why I still have to her subsequent letters. You'll also get Genius Girl's Melancholy achievement. When Suzuha letters to you about Akhabara, respond peacefully and get her next message to get the Pride Warrior Girls achievement. When Faris emails you about The Sign of The Increase of Unhappiness the answer is with it. When Mayuri emails you about the Exit Response with Crunchy-Kun. When Mayuri emails you about Luke, who may be a part through subsequent exchanges with Faris, reply with Kakeru-kun and open the attachment on her next post to make progress on Hero RaiNet Achievement. When Faris emails you again about the ability to respond with NyanNyanian to get Cat's Tea Time achievement when you get her next message. Also, reply with Chinchilla Star, then Ep 8 on her next post, and then open the attachment to the post after that to finish the Hero RaiNet achievement. Chapter 5 There are no real branches in this chapter, but you'll see some different scenes depending on whether or not you caused the True Ending flag in the previous chapter. You can still save if you collect achievements. When Faris calls, answer it for a pretty chuunibyoutu chat. If you called True Ending Flag last chapter, Kurisu will email you about the plans. Respond to travel expenses and read her next message (called Idiott), which you don't have to respond to. Later you get another message from her and it unlocks the second True Ending flag. If you don't call True Ending Flag in the last chapter, you'll get an email from Mayuri saying that made me happy today - reply with a cosplay and read the following post to get Passion's Best Forgotten Achievement. Also answer with Fubuki-chan and Kaede-chan and then open the attachment to her next message to get the Princess of Chaos achievement. When Faris emails you about ComMa, reply with a collapse and open an attachment to her next message to get The Songs of Chaos an achievement. Chapter 6 BEFORE! This chapter gives you the opportunity to reach the end, and there are several different scenes based on the choices you make. Save if you want to see them all. Shortly after the row... Did it work? - you will have the opportunity to do nothing or call Mayuri. If you don't do anything, you'll see an extra scene. On the line I have to call or send an email calling Luke for an extra scene. On the line I wonder how other lab mems progress, call Kurisu, Mayuri or Dara for a scene with them, or do nothing for the scene with Suzuha. When given the opportunity to send D-Mail at the end of the chapter, do nothing to reach the end of Suzuha and finish the game. Also, send A-Mail to continue. Chapter 7 BEFORE! This is another chapter where achievement choices and True Ending choices are mutually exclusive. If you have taken two true Ending flags available so far, Kurisu will email you about The answer I have is no key then to her next post and then open the attachment to the post afterwards to make progress on Froggy Demise Achievement. Then restart your save. Now the answer is from the house, then Hyahha on her next post, then I'm going to give it straight to one after that and then open the attachment to her Blazing Heat! Message to finish off Froggy Fad Demise achievement. Also, select I have no key and then security to her next post and then the reality to post after that and then read the final answer to the third True Ending flag. When Daru calls, answer him for an additional scene. When Kuris calls, answer her on stage with her, or ignore her for the scene with Faris. When given the opportunity to send A-Mail at the end of the chapter, do nothing to reach the end of Faris and finish the game. Also, send A-Mail to continue. Chapter 8 BEFORE! There is another end to this chapter. If you have three True Ending flags so far, Kurisu will email you. Read it and then read her next post later in the chapter for the fourth True Ending flag. If you have the option of whether or not to call PhoneWave (name subject to change) do nothing to get an extra call from Daru. After the line Will you ... Remember me? Don't call PhoneWave to reach the end of Luke and finish the game. Also, call PhoneWave to continue. Chapter 9 is the only minor branch in this chapter. Save if you want to be thorough and explore all options. On the straight line Should I really jump now? do nothing for the extra scene during which Kurisu will call you. Answer it for another additional scene. When Kuris calls later in the chapter, ignore him for a scene with Moeka. If you have all four True Ending flags so far, Kurisu will email you with the theme Contact me, idiot! Answer with bothers and read her next post for the fifth True Ending flag. When given the opportunity to send a D-Mail at the end of the chapter, do nothing for the extra scene and CG. Chapter 10 If you don't have True Ending flags, when you get to the beginning of this chapter, you're locked in at the end of Mayuri. Otherwise, you'll see either Kurisu or True Ending. If you have five of the six True Ending flags, reply where you are to Kuris' message to block True Ending. When Mayuri calls, answer him for an additional scene. Finally, your end will be determined by how many True Ending flags you have. If you don't have them, you'll get the end of Mayuri. If you have 1-5, you will get the ending of Kuris.
